The house sits in two acres of garden with wooded walk and commands excellent views across the Firth of Forth from Dunbar to Edinburgh.

The village of Colinsburgh, founded by Colin the 3rd Earl of Crawford for his disbanded troops in 1682, is a quarter of a mile away and has a well stocked shop with post office, a petrol station and a pub with food.

The villages of Elie, Kilconquhar, St Monans, Pittenweem and Anstruther are all close by, as are several blue flag beaches.

Northfield is a convenient base from which to visit places such as the famous old town of St Andrews, Edinburgh, Dundee and many other places.
